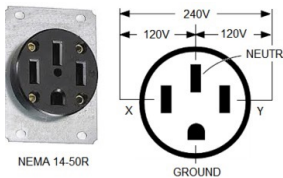

You will have available 2 15/20 amp 120 volt duplex outlets that will yield 40 amps of power.

OR

#2



You will have available 1 - 50 amp 240 volt outlet that will yield 50 amps of power.

OR

#3 If you have a pigtail* to “hardwire” into our breaker box, we can wire your pigtail to 50 amp 240V circuit. Your pigtail should have 4 wires to allow a proper connection.

OR

#4 If you have a pigtail* to “hardwire” into our breaker box, we can wire your pigtail to a 30 amp 120 Volt circuit.

#4 If you have a pigtail* to “hardwire” into our breaker box, we can wire your pigtail to a 30 amp 120 Volt circuit. Your pigtail should have 3 wires to allow a proper connection.

* If you intend to be hardwired to our breaker box, you must have a minimum of 75 feet of cord suited to carry the load you are requesting.

Please circle the power setup that you will need for our event. There will be additional 15/20 amp circuits available, but only 1 50 amp 240 receptacle will be available for each food vendor.

Please be prepared to adapt to our system. We are asking for this information to allow us to be prepared to supply stable power while you are vending at our event. We want to be ready to connect you as soon as you arrive.

Please return this with your completed registration sheet and payment. We will contact you 2 weeks prior to the event to reconfirm the information listed below.
